Joshua 1.1-5 After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, it came to pass that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying: 2 "Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the children of Israel. 3 "Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses. 4 "From the wilderness and this Lebanon as far as the great river, the River Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and to the Great Sea toward the going down of the sun, shall be your

territory. 5 “No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you.

The promised land is you and I living in our full potential.

God wants us living in our full potential.

An inheritance is something that has been prepared for you!

Proverbs 13:22 A good man leaves an inheritance to his children’s children, But the wealth of the sinner is stored up for the righteous.

1 Peter 2:9 But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people,

We need to go into enemy held territory and take back what the enemy the devil has stolen.

Psalms 24:1 The earth is the LORD's, and all its fullness, The world and those who dwell therein. 2 For He has founded it upon the seas, And established it upon the waters.

Deuteronomy 15:4b ;for the LORD will greatly bless you in the land which the LORD your God is giving you to possess as an inheritance.

The Bible speaks of an eternal inheritance.

1 Peter 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, 4 to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and

that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,

Revelations 21:7 “He who overcomes shall inherit all things, and I will be his God and he shall be My son.

The Bible also talks about an inheritance now.

2 Corinthians 1:20-22 For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us. 22 Now He who establishes us with you in Christ and has anointed us is God, 22 who also has sealed us and given us the Spirit in our hearts as a guarantee.

The Holy Spirit is the down payment, He is the deposit of our inheritance.

But that doesn't guarantee you will live in it.

It just means your inheritance is available.

We have to go after it!

40x in Scripture (both past tense):

"God has given you the land."

"The Land God has given us."

Inherit is the Hebrew word Yarash it's mentioned 265 times in the Bible.

"to occupy, by driving out previous tenants and possessing their place; to seize, to inherit, also to expel"

City takers are those who remove the unlawful tenants from their real estate.

Joshua 3:9-10 So Joshua said to the children of Israel, "Come here, and hear the words of the LORD your God." 10 And

Joshua said, “By this you shall know that the living God is among you, and that He will without fail drive out from before you the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Hivites and the Perizzites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Jebusites:

Canaan was a land of Fortified Cities. Fortified is spiritual and or physical real-estate that requires acts of faith, obedience and the displacement of opposition in order to possess.

Canaanites were merchants who humiliate.

They were financial giants who were motivated by greed and material accumulation.

Hittites were a terrifying and intimidating people; Creating fear, confusion, and discouragement in their enemies.

Amorites were warlike, vicious talkers.

They were arrogant and boastful in their speech, verbally corrupt; they always challenged their enemies.

Joshua 23:9-13 For The LORD has driven out great and powerful nations for you, and no one has yet been able to defeat you. Each one of you will put to flight a thousand of the enemy, for the LORD your God fights for you, just as He has promised. So be very careful to love the LORD your God. But if you turn away from Him and cling to the customs of the survivors of these nations remaining among you, and if you intermarry with them, then know for certain that the LORD your God

will no longer drive them out of your land. Instead, they will be a snare and a trap to you, a whip for your backs and thorny brambles in your eyes, and you will vanish from this good land the LORD your God has given you.

If you don't evict the enemies from your potential real estate they will eventually disqualify you from living there.

For every enemy in your Promised Land, there is a supernatural strategy to drive them out.

The real estate is won in your heart.

One person can kill a giant but it takes a congregation to take a city.
